IN SPITE OF HER BUSY LIFE, ROZA ALSO ACCEPTED A VOLUNTEER POSITION AT THE POLISH SENIOR'S CLUB.

MORE RECENTLY, ROZA SPEARHEADED AID FOR MAKSYMILIAN CHLEWINSKI, A PROMISING, BLIND PIANIST IN POLAND.

THROUGH ALL THE YEARS, SHE HAS BEEN AN ACTIVE CONTRIBUTOR TO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CANADIAN POLISH CONGRESS. ACCORDINGLY, IT CAME AS NO GREAT SURPRISE THAT THE CONGRESS AWARDED ROZA WITH THEIR HONORARY BRONZE MEDAL IN 1999.
